Footnotes

PIGTAILS tracked the early pacesetters while racing three wide, rallied three wide on the final turn, took command entering the stretch and quickly drew clear. NUJ NUJ WINK WINK unhurried early while dropping back to trail, rallied one from the rail on the final turn, tipped four wide into the stretch and closed late to get up for the place. DE VILBISS chased the pace three wide into the first turn, rallied one from the rail on the final turn in a game effort. AQUATIC away alertly and chased the pacesetters into the first turn while just out from the rail, held a stalking position down the backside, but failed to improve her position in an even effort. ACCEPTABLE HENNA raced one from the rail into the first turn, rallied four wide on the final turn but lacked the needed closing response. LUISINA away well and stalked the early pace from along the rail, but weakened over the final furlong. MEDANO BEACH broke sharply and rushed to the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, dueled for the lead from along the inside down the backside but faded over the final furlong.
