WESTERLY WIND never far back on the inside, off the rail, rallied from four wide, gained the lead at mid stretch and won driving. YOLLA LAD away alertly, tracked the leaders from off the rail, rallied from three wide and was second best. ZEKES' BEST TRICK in the middle of the pace, gaining from three wide, rallied and finished well. DUBA broke sharply, gained command from the inside set a pressured pace, gave way. FIVE BOLD RINGS broke sharply, pressed the pace from the outside, gave way. THATSA GIMME JIMMY broke sharply, chased the leaders from three wide, was through early and dropped back. YOO DA BOSS trailed early, showed little and was not a threat. FLAMING BOG unprepared for the start, showed little and was not a factor.
