GABIGOTHERWAY away well and chased the early pacesetter one from the rail into the first turn, tracked the leader one from the rail in the run down the backside, engaged WHAT A SCORE entering the final turn, took a clear lead into the stretch and drew clear. SUNNYSIDE GAL broke sharply and chased the pace three wide into the first turn, rallied three wide into the final turn, was unable to match strides with GABIGOTHERWAY through the final furlong but proved clearly second best. WHAT A SCORE away alertly and rushed to the lead entering the first turn, held a narrow advantage into the final turn but was quickly collared, and faded in the stretch drive. DANCE THE WIND allowed to settle well off the early leaders racing one from the rail, rallied three wide on the final turn and improved her position while closing four wide through the lane. JOEY LA BAMBA chased the pace four wide into the first turn, continued on from the outside in the run down the backside, rallied three wide on the final turn, drifted in entering the stretch and finished along the rail. UNDO IT raced one from the rail into the first turn, was four wide down the backstretch and never seriously menaced. DIAMOND DANCER stalked the early leaders racing one from the rail, but faded over the final furlong. INDULGE trailed throughout and showed little.
