**Footnotes**

HERESCOMELUCKY away well and tracked the early pacesetters while racing three wide down the backside, rallied one from the rail on the final turn, tipped four wide in the stretch, took command in mid stretch and drew clear. JOINT CHOICE away alertly and vied for the early lead from along the rail entering the first turn, raced on the lead down the backside one from the rail, held the lead into the stretch but was unable to hold off HERESCOMELUCKY. ALBERTA BREEZE broke sharply and dueled for the lead into the first turn racing one from the rail, took back to assume a stalking position upon entering the backstretch, rallied three wide on the final turn and closed five wide through the lane. SIMON TEMPLAR tracked the early leaders one from the rail into the backstretch, saved ground throughout in an even effort. HELLO FRANKIE chased the pace into the first turn while three wide, pressed JOINT CHOICE for the lead down the backside from a three wide trip, was unable to match strides with that foe over the final furlong and faded late. QUATRILL'S RAIDER raced four wide into the backstretch, remained wide throughout and was never a factor. SARTORIALIST unhurried early while dropping back to trail, but failed to ever menace. SHINGEN BOLT raced one from the rail into the first turn, rallied four wide on the final turn but lacked the needed closing response. ROYAL VICTOR was squeezed at the start to get away slowly, raced wide into the backstretch and was never a factor.
