CLASS INCLUDED away alertly and stalked the early pacesetters while racing three wide through the stretch the first time around, tracked the leaders three wide down the backside, rallied three wide on the final turn, entered the lane with a clear advantage, and was drew clear in the lane. CASTINETTE DANCER raced mid pack while five wide through the second turn, rallied four wide entering the final turn, and proved second best while no match for the winner. OVERVALUED broke sharply and rushed to the lead entering the first turn while racing one from the rail, pressed the pace from the outside of EMBELLISHED in the run down the backstretch,lost command mid way through the final turn and faded slightly in the stretch. TECOLOTE showed no early speed while lagging towards the back of the field, rallied four wide entering the final turn, moved into contention mid way through the final turn, and finished evenly. PLAYFUL ARGUMENT allowed to settle while racing one from the rail, rallied three wide entering the final turn, and finished evenly. EMBELLISHED away well and chased the early leader into the stretch the first time, advanced to vied for the lead from along the rail entering the second turn, battled from the inside of OVERVALUED down the backside, but weakened over the final furlong. QUEEN'S VICAR tracked the leaders through the early stages from along the rail, but began to drop back soon after entering the backstretch. LEMON LOAF unhurried early while racing one from the rail, saved ground down the backside but failed to menace. SKOPA unhurried early while dropping back to trail, appeared to lose her action behind entering the first turn, the rider lost his irons and was pulled up. Following the running of the race the stewards conducted an enquiry into an incident entering the first turn, in regards to SKOPA. After review the stewards made no change to the original order of finish
