NUMAANY broke sharply, pressed the early pace from the inside, gained the lead at the half, drew clear, was ridden out. HARLEM slow early, gaining on the inside, rallied from three wide, was second best. WINDY DAY away alertly and close up, chased the leaders from the inside, rallied on the two path and finished well. MILITARY DEPUTY trailed early, gaining from off the rail, rallied from four wide and finished well. DIAMONDS LIL DEVIL in the middle of the pack, stalked the pace from off the rail, had no rally. SLEWS PROSPECT broke sharply, assumed command set the early pace, gave way. CANDLESTICK PARK never far back, gaining from three wide, weakened after a mile. POLAR BLUE unhurried early, dropped back, only passed tired rivals. JUST LIKE DREADS unhurried early, showed little and was not a threat. VINTNER away alertly, saved ground, was through after three quarters. CHILE'S QUEST in the middle of the pack, stalked the pace from off the rail, was through after a half.
