Footnotes

HILLINGDON hesitated at the break to get away slowly, trailed the field through the second turn while racing two from the rail, rallied three wide entering the final turn, took command in mid stretch and drew clear. MARCADO away alertly and raced to the lead from just off the rail entering the first turn, vied for the lead from the inside of LONG LORRIE in the run down the backside and through the final turn, took a narrow advantage into the stretch, but was no match for HILLINGDON in the late stages while proving clearly second best. LONG LORRIE tracked the early leader three wide through the first turn, pressed the pace from the outside of MARCADO down the backside and through the final turn, but was outfinished in the late going. COMMANDRESS allowed to settle off the early leaders while saving ground at the rail, rallied along the inside entering the final turn and loomed a danger entering the stretch, but lacked the needed closing response in the stretch drive. PRINCESS ZAIDA broke sharply, but was allowed to settle off the early pace while racing one from the rail through the second turn, rallied two wide entering the final turn, but faded in the late stages. REMEMBERING WHEN away well and stalked the battling leaders one from the rail through the second turn, held a striking position to the final turn before weakening.
