Footnotes

GOLDEN TRIUMPH away alertly and raced to a narrow advantage entering the first turn racing two from the rail, opened a clear lead in the run down the backstretch and widened his margin through the final furlong. SHINTOISM showed no early speed while lagging well back of the early pace racing one from the rail into the backstretch, rallied along the inside through the final turn before tipping four wide entering the stretch and closed willingly to get up for the place. RUFFY JOE away well and stalked the early leaders four wide into the first turn, rallied three from the rail on the final turn and closed with interest in a solid effort. DASH SMARTLY tracked the early leaders from just off the rail entering the first turn, took up the chase rallying one from the rail entering the final turn, was unable to gain ground on the leader through the turn and was outfinished late. DOUBLE IT unhurried early while dropping back to trail, rallied three wide through the final turn and closed three wide in the lane while improving his position. BRASS AND GOLD settled off the early leaders racing along the rail into the backstretch, rallied along the inside on the final turn but hung slightly in the stretch drive. GOLDFIRE stalked the early leaders racing two wide into the first turn, rallied one from the rail entering the final turn but was forced to steady sharply mid way through the final turn when put in tight quarters, and closed six wide through the stretch. TIMELESS STORM broke sharply and tracked the early leader four wide into the first turn, held a stalking position to the final turn before weakening.
