**Footnotes**

MATCHABULL away well and stalked the early pace while racing one from the rail, rallied two wide on the final turn and ran down VIMANA in the final strides. VIMANA broke sharply and tracked the early leader while racing three wide into the first turn, advanced along the rail on the final turn, took command entering the stretch but was unable to hold off MATCHABULL in the closing strides. PROFIT'S STAR allowed to settle off the early pace, rallied three wide into the stretch and improved his position over the final furlong. TAI SHAN unhurried early while dropping back to trail, raced one from the rail down the backside and failed to ever menace. DOG ROCK saved ground throughout while racing along the rail, but was never a factor. NONE OF THAT away alertly and sprinted to a clear lead entering the first turn racing one from the rail, raced three wide down the backside, drifted wide on the final turn and weakened in the stretch drive.
