JUMP PASS away alertly, pressed the pace, shuffled back, rallied from three wide, gained the lead at mid stretch and drew clear. SNOW MOON hustled along from four wide, pressed the pace from off the rail, weakened in the stretch. TOUGH TORQUE broke sharply, assumed command, set the pace from off the rail, gave way, bore in on the upper stretch forcing GOLD TICKET to check. RIBOLETTO never far back, stalked the pace from off the rail, put in a mild rally from four wide for no gain. GOLD TICKET hustled along, chased the leaders from the inside, steadied on the upper stretch when TOUGH TORQUE bore in. COLONEL COURTNEY broke sharply, close up, chased the leaders from three wide, weakened after the half. ROAD TO LUCK trailed for most of the trip, showed little and was not a factor. BLASTING GUNN slow early, showed little and was not a threat. Following the race there was a stewards enquiry and a riders claim of foul. The rider of GOLD TICKET claimed foul against the rider of TOUGH TORQUE for interference on the upper stretch. After review the claim of foul was upheld. TOUGH TORQUE was disqualified and placed, fifth.
