A Grade III Special Weight Stakes for Three Year Old Fillies. By subscription of \$200 to accompany the nomination due on Wednesday, September 12. With \$1,000 to enter and \$1,000 to pass scratch time. With \$100,000 added and an additional \$25,000 from the Breeders' Cup Fund for Cup nominees only. All Hastings Entertainment Inc. purse money to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. Breeders' Cup Fund monies correspondingly divided providing a Breeders' Cup nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup Fund monies not awarded will revert back to the Fund. Field will be limited to twelve starters. This race will not be divided. Preference will be based on current year earnings as recorded by The Daily Racing Form at time of entry. In a case where horses have identical earnings, preference will be given to the Breeders' Cup eligible horse. Weight: 121 lbs. A trophy will be given to the winning owner by Breeders' Cup Ltd.

ALPINE GARDEN broke sharply, pressed the pace from the outside, rallied and gained the lead on the backstretch, drew clear and won driving. PAT OF GOLD broke sharply and was well placed, saved ground, off the rail to rally from three wide, was second best. NAPA trailed for the first three quarters, rallied from four wide into the stretch, closed and finished well. TANIKA broke sharply, chased the leaders from three wide, shuffled back, put in a mild rally from four wide at the quarter pole, finished well. SUVA in the middle of the pack, stalked the pace from the inside, made a bid from five wide at the quarter pole, gained a minor share. LAND OF SILVER unhurried early, showed little and was not a threat. RIVOLTELLA hustled along, gaining from four wide, chased, was through after three quarters. DEADLY ZONE broke sharply, gained command from the outside, set a pressured pace, gave way.
