Footnotes

MAZEL'S SECRET showed no early speed while racing four wide into the first turn, continued from the outside in the run down the backstretch, rallied four wide entering the final turn, took command in mid stretch and quickly drew clear. BUFFALO BABE away well and raced to the lead from along the inside entering the first turn, held the lead through the final turn racing just out from the rail, was unable to match strides with MAZEL'S SECRET in deep stretch but proved clearly second best. RAVENETTE broke sharply and stalked the leaders through the first turn racing one from the rail, raced five wide down the backstretch, rallied three wide through the final turn and closed willingly six wide in the stretch drive. STOLEN unhurried early while dropping back to trail, raced just out from the rail in the run to the final turn, rallied two wide entering the turn and closed with interest four wide in the lane. ALLUSHA stalked the

leader three wide into the first turn, rallied two from the rail entering the final turn, and closed five wide in the stretch drive. SPIRIT WANDERING tracked the leader one from the rail down the backside, rallied two wide on the final turn, but faded in the late going. RISKY DEVIL showed no early speed while lagging well back of the leaders, rallied along the rail on the final turn and improved her position through the final furlong without ever threatening. ANNA POTENTIAL stalked the leaders into the first turn racing two from the rail, held a striking position through the final turn but weakened in the stretch. PVT. SALLY WILSON stalked the leaders four wide into the backstretch, rallied three from the rail entering the final turn but faded in the late stages. LOOKOUT COUNTY away alertly and settled off the early leaders while saving ground along the rail into the backstretch, held a striking position to the final turn but lacked the closing response needed when called upon. SISTERRELL was bumped at the start to get away slowly, raced one from the rail into the first turn, and never menaced.
