MOSEL RIVER broke sharply, chased and pressed the pace from off the rail, gained the lead on the second turn, prevailed driving. MOBIL SUPREME unhurried early, gaining from off the rail, rallied from three wide, closed and was second best. GUNS N GOLD trailed for the first half mile, rallied from four wide, closed and finished well. ROYAL RAGS broke sharply and was well placed, gaining, three wide on the backstretch, weakened in the stretch. ROYAL BANNER broke sharply, assumed command, gained the rail, set the pace, gave way. NORTHERN IRELAND broke sharply, allowed to settle, gaining on the inside, weakened. PRIVATE INTENTION in the middle of the pack, three wide on the first turn, dropped back.
