KANONKULE away alertly and rushed to the lead one from the rail entering the first turn, opened a clear advantage through the stretch the first time, increased his advantage in the run down the backstretch and was never challenged. GOOD BAD N UGLY away well and stalked the early pace while racing four wide, rallied four wide on the final turn, and just got up for the place in deep stretch. SMART CALL broke sharply and chased the early leader while saving ground at the rail, finished willingly from along the inside in the stretch drive in an even effort. NORTHWAY chased the early pacesetter while racing one from the rail, raced three wide down the backside but began to fade in the stretch drive. GREAT PRINCE allowed to settle while racing one from the rail, rallied two wide on the final turn, and closed three wide in the lane. OLAXSA unhurried early while dropping back to trail, saved ground throughout but failed to menace. KALOOKAN BOSS raced three wide down the backside, posted a mild bid five wide nearing the final turn but flattened out over the final furlong.
