Footnotes

DIANA'S LEGACY tracked the early leaders while saving ground at the rail, advanced two wide mid way down the backstretch and pressed for the lead from the outside of B.C. CAT entering the final turn, took command entering the stretch and quickly drew off. VYING TY GRR broke sharply and angled in to save ground entering the first turn while settling well off the early leaders, rallied at the rail on the final turn and closed three wide in the stretch to prove clearly second best. SEE EYE TO EYE unhurried early while dropping back to trail, rallied two wide on the final turn and closed willingly three wide in the stretch. WE ARE ONE chased the leaders three wide into the first turn, rallied three wide on the final turn and improved her position while closing five wide in the lane. B. C. CAT rushed up from along the rail to vie for the early lead entering the first turn, took command in the run down the backside, held a narrow advantage into the final turn, but faded in the stretch. PRINCESS RAINIER away well and chased the early pace one from the rail into the first turn, tracked the leaders down the backside but lacked the needed closing response. TAMARINDA away alertly and dueled for the early lead while three wide, raced four wide down the backside, and weakened over the final furlong. NICOTIANA chased the leaders four wide into the first turn, continued down the backside from a four wide trip, but was through before reaching the final turn.
