LAGUNA BLAZE broke sharply, and dueled for the lead from between rivals entering the first turn, battled from the inside of RIDE THE SKY in the run down the backstretch while racing out from the rail, shook loose from that rival leaving the turn, and held the closers safely at bay in deep stretch. DEADSET stalked the leaders into the first turn while racing one from the rail, rallied three wide entering the final turn, while looking for room from between rivals, and closed willingly three wide in the stretch drive. KOFFEE GRINDER was off a step slow, and angled in to save ground as he settled off the early pacesetters entering the first turn, rallied along the inside entering the final turn, and closed determinedly from along the rail through the lane to just miss the place. RED RIVERMAN away well, and vied for the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, took back off the leaders in the run down the backstretch, and tipped for wide for clear sailing, rallied four wide through the final turn, and finished five wide in the drive. RIDE THE SKY away alertly, and pressed the leaders three wide entering the first turn, continued to force the issue from the outside of LAGUNA BLAZE down the backside and through the final turn, while racing three from the rail, but faded in the stretch drive. PROMISE GLORY was slow in the early going, while dropping well off the pace, and trailed throughout.
