SEE EYE TO EYE raced mid pack into the backstretch racing one from the rail, advanced mid way down the backside while racing three wide, rallied four wide into the stretch, took command in deep stretch and drew clear. B. C. CAT broke sharply and vied for the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, battled down the backstretch and into the final turn from the inside of SNOWBIRD PASS, held a narrow advantage into the lane, but was no match for the winner in deep stretch but battled gamely to hold the place. DE VILBISS broke inwards and stalked the early leaders while saving ground at the rail, rallied along the inside on the final turn and closed willingly in a solid effort. EILEEN IS A SAINT stalked the pacesetters one from the rail into the backstretch, rallied four wide on the final turn but needed more of a closing response when called upon in the late stages. BEAUTIFUL BREEZE away well and tracked the early leaders one from the rail into the backstretch, rallied two wide on the final turn but was outfinished in the stretch drive. MIA DOLCE was bumped at the start, and settled off the early pace racing four wide into the first turn, but was only able to post a mild late bid three wide in the stretch drive. TICK ME OFF settled well off the early pace while saving ground at the rail, but failed to menace. EPIC ADVENTURE showed no early speed while lagging well back,

raced three wide down the backside but failed to be a factor. SNOWBIRD PASS away alertly and dueled for the lead from the outside of B.C. CAT into the first turn and down the backside, battled through the turn but faded in the stretch drive. WESTERN WHERE unhurried early while dropping back to trail, and was never a factor.
