Footnotes

NORTHERN CAUSEWAY stalked the pacesetters racing three wide through the first turn, raced four wide down the backside and into the final turn, and closed six wide through the stretch to be up in time. POP ARTIST tracked the early leader racing three wide into the first turn, rallied three wide entering the final turn and closed five wide through the stretch. JUMP UP AND KISSME settled off the early pace racing one from the rail into the first turn, rallied two wide on the final turn and split rivals while closing gamely through the lane. THREE WOOD unhurried early while dropping back to trail racing three wide into the first turn, rallied two from the rail entering the final turn and was gaining from between rivals through the stretch drive. BRIARTIC COUNTY broke sharply and tracked the leader into the backstretch while saving ground at the rail, rallied along the inside on the final turn but was outfinished in the drive. GOLDEN TRIUMPH away alertly and raced to the lead one from the rail into the first turn, raced three wide down the backside while controlling the pace, but faded in deep stretch. STOLENOTIS away well and settled off the early pace while saving ground at the rail, but showed little when called upon.
