Footnotes

LA BELLE ROSE broke sharply and stalked the early leader racing one from the rail through the stretch the first time, pressed the pace from the outside of JOEY'S JEWEL entering the backstretch, held a narrow advantage into the stretch and drew clear in the lane. PIGTAILS was off a step slow, rolled up to track the early pacesetter three wide into the stretch the first time, engaged to press the pace three wide upon entering the backside, dueled through the final turn from the outside of LA BELLE ROSE, but was unable to match strides with that rival through the stretch. EMBANKMENT away alertly and rushed to the lead from along the rail into the first turn, was forced to steady when in tight entering the second turn, rallied three wide on the final turn to get up for a share. JOEY'S JEWEL hopped at the start to get away slowly, trailed into the stretch the first time while saving ground at the rail, rushed four wide entering the second turn to take command, vied for the lead from along the rail down the backstretch but faded over the final furlong. LA BRONCA unhurried early while lagging back three wide, continued wide down the backside and failed to menace. SKOPA stalked the early leaders from along the rail, seemed to lose her action mid way down the backstretch and dropped well behind the field and was unable to recover. Following the running of this race there was a stewards inquiry into the incident down the backstretch involving SKOPA. After review the stewards made no change to the original order of finish.
