All supplemental nominees will be pre-entered in the race. Entry and supplemental fees will be refunded to any horse that fails to draw into this race due to preference requirements. With \$75,000 Guaranteed to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. **Footnotes**

WITH COUNCIL allowed to settle well off the early leaders racing one from the rail, advanced one from the rail from between rivals approaching the final turn, rallied two wide on the turn, tipped five wide into the stretch, took command in deep stretch and drew clear. LORD HENRY broke sharply and chased the early pace while racing three wide, held a narrow advantage into the stretch but was unable to hold off a late charge by WITH COUNCIL. HERESCOMELUCKY away alertly and stalked the early leaders one from the rail into the first turn, pressed four wide into the second turn, loomed the main danger entering the final turn, but was outfinished in the stretch. SHINGEN BOLT unhurried early while dropping back to trail, saved ground through the turns while racing along the rail, rallied five wide on the final turn and improved his position without ever threatening. TON OF PRIDE allowed to settle early while saving ground at the rail, rallied three wide on the final turn, but needed more to be a threat. EL NACHO away well and rushed to an early lead from along the inside, vied into the backstretch from the inside of LORD HENRY, but weakened over the final furlong. LUCKY MOLY MINER raced mid pack while four wide through the stretch the first time, advanced five wide entering the second turn, but faded as they approached the final turn. JOINT CHOICE tracked the pacesetters while racing one from the rail into the second turn, but began to fade soon after entering the backstretch.
