PATH TO HOME broke sharply and was close up on the inside, chased the leaders, rallied on the two path, gained the lead at mid stretch, prevailed driving. CHAPEL BOY unhurried early, stalked the pace, rallied from three wide, closed and just missed. FUNNY FACE broke sharply, gained command, set a pressured pace, gave way. ROSSINO broke sharply, allowed to settle, rallied from five wide out of the second turn and finished well. AFTERNOON RAIN broke sharply, pressed the pace from the outside, weakened after the half. J D LOOKS GOOD NOW slow early, showed little and was not a threat. SAGEHILL'S STORM away alertly and close up, chased the leaders from three and four wide, was through after the half. BILODEAU off slowly, trailed, made a late gain.
