Footnotes

JEBRICA tracked the early pace racing three wide, rallied four wide on the final turn and closed strongly to get up in the closing strides. WINNING MACHINE chased the early pace one from the rail, tracked the pacesetter three wide down the backside, rallied four wide on the final turn, and battled gamely through the stretch. ASSESSMENT chased the early pace while three wide, pressed the pacesetter one from the rail down the backside, held a narrow advantage entering the stretch but hung in the late going. COMMANDER vied for the early lead from along the rail, opened a wide advantage down the backstretch, settled through the stretch the second time and took up a stalking position from along the rail, dueled two wide down the backside the final time, and battled gamely through the final furlong. THREE WOOD showed no speed early while lagging towards the back of the field, rallied one from the rail on the final turn and was gaining in the stretch drive. CREW LEADER settled through the early going saving ground from along the inside, posted a mild bid approaching the final turn but needed more over the final furlong. ALMOST TIME unhurried early while dropping back to trail, rallied five wide on the final turn but hung in the stretch. FINALLY KRUISIN tracked the early leaders from the outside, rallied three wide entering the final turn but was unable to threaten. TRICK OF THE NORTH saved ground throughout but failed to menace. SENOR ROJO allowed to settle while saving ground at the rail, posted a mild mid down the backside the final time but flattened out over the final furlong. GANBEI raced two wide throughout and was never a factor. SILLY FELLA tracked the leaders down the backside, but tired approaching the final turn.
