SIR GALLANT broke sharply, assumed command from the inside, led throughout drew clear on the second turn and won driving. NINELEVENTURBO away alertly and close up, chased the leaders from off the rail, rallied and was second best. JOY OF THE LORD never far back, gaining from off the rail, rallied from three wide and finished well. GOLD TICKET away alertly, stalked the pace from the inside, weakened in the stretch. SAVO ISLAND broke sharply, pressed the pace, three wide on the backstretch, gave way. VISION OF ROSES trailed for most of the trip, made a late gain, failed to menace. FORCEFUL INTENTION broke sharply, gaining from three wide, was through after a half.
