**Footnotes**

WITHOUT INCIDENT away alertly and tracked the leader one from the rail into the backstretch, engaged the pacesetter two wide entering the turn, battled with SACRED CAUSE through the final furlong and prevailed in the closing strides. SACRED CAUSE away well and tracked the leader into the first turn racing two from the rail, rallied three wide entering the final turn to collar WITHOUT INCIDENT, held a narrow advantage into the stretch, but was unable to hold that rival off, as he re-rallied in deep stretch. I TOLD FRANK tracked the leader four wide into the first turn, rallied along the inside on the final turn and closed willingly through the stretch. INCA ROCA raced mid pack while one from the rail entering the first turn, advanced along the inside in the run to the final turn, rallied three wide into the turn, but finished evenly through the stretch. MARK settled off the pace racing three wide into the first turn, rallied four wide entering the final turn but needed more of a closing response in the stretch drive. CHECKERPLATE was slow into stride while lagging well off the pace, and failed to menace. WANDERINGTERROR broke sharply and raced to the lead from along the inside entering the first turn, continued on the lead into the backstretch racing one from the rail, but weakened entering the final turn. SECOND ECLIPSE was slow into stride, and was never a factor. HE'S MY BRO unhurried early, bore out entering the first turn, and was pulled up on the backstretch. HE'S MY BRO walked off the track.
