Footnotes

TEMPEST broke sharply, and vied for the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, battled down the backstretch and through the final turn from the inside of CARSON CITY BROWN, took a narrow advantage into the stretch, and prevailed over a very determined foe. CARSON CITY BROWN chased four wide into the first turn, and pressed the pacesetter one from the rail entering the backstretch, battled through the final turn and through the stretch from the outside of TEMPEST, and proved clearly second best. LONDON away alertly, and duelled for the lead one from the rail entering the first turn, before being eased back into a stalking trip as they entered the backstretch, rallied two from the rail entering the final turn, and closed with late interest three wide in the drive. WHERO tracked the leaders none from the rail entering the first turn, sat a stalking trip from along the inside in the run down the backstretch, rallied along the rail on the final turn, and closed willingly, while finishing evenly, in a solid effort. ITS FINALLY FRIDAY was off a step slow, but recovered quickly and settled off the early pace while saving ground at the rail entering the first turn, rallied one from the rail entering the final turn, and closed with late interest three wide in the drive. MARRUK away well, and pressed the pace three wide in the run to the first turn, but was forced to check off heels entering the turn, and dropped into a stalking trip while racing two from the rail, rallied three wide entering the final turn, and closed willingly. WEE HARRY settled well off the early pace while racing four wide entering the first turn, commenced a four wide rally entering the final turn, but needed more of a closing response when called upon. C B KOSMO settled off the early pace racing two from the rail into the backstretch, but lacked a closing response. HOLY CHEROOT settled off the early leaders racing one from the rail into the backstretch, rallied four wide entering the final turn, but weakened in the late going. ROY'S DREAM unhurried early, while dropping back to trail, and was unable to make an impact.
