Footnotes

LORNEFIVEHUNDRED settled off the early pace racing three wide into the first turn, raced four wide in the run down the backstretch, rallied four wide entering the final turn, took command soon after entering the lane, and quickly drew clear. PAKAL away well, and dueled for the lead one from the rail entering the first turn, took command mid way down the backstretch and opened a clear lead, was collared by the winner shortly after entering the stretch, and while no match for that rival, battled gamely to hold the place. MIA'S MIRACLE away alertly, and tracked the leaders one from the rail entering the first turn, rallied three wide entering the final turn, and closed willingly three wide in the drive to just miss the place. SURPRISE SALE bumped soon after the start, and settled off the early leaders while racing along the inside entering the first turn, rallied two wide entering the final turn, and closed with a rush one from the rail in the drive. GANBEI lagged well back in the early going, racing three wide into the first turn, commenced his rally one from the rail entering the final turn, drifted five wide in deep stretch while under left handed urging, and bumped with a rival in the final strides. DEPUTY'S COMMAND unhurried early, while dropping back to trail, rallied four wide entering the final turn, and closed willingly five wide in the lane, and was bumped in the closing strides. LOOKOUT DUBAI stalked the early leaders while racing one from the rail into the backstretch, rallied three wide entering the final turn, but faded in the stretch drive. STORM'S BATTLE broke sharply, and vied for the lead from the rail entering the first turn, was unable to keep tabs on PAKAL in the run to the final turn, and began to weaken, and was forced to steady sharply entering the final turn, when put in tight quarters. Following the running of this race there was a jockey's claim of foul. The rider of DEPUTY'S COMMAND lodged a claim of foul against the rider of GANBEI, for alleged interference in deep stretch. After review the stewards disallowed the claim of foul, and made no change to the original order of finish.
