SUFI DANCER away well and tracked the dueling leaders racing three wide into the stretch the first time, advanced three wide to press the leader into the final turn, was collared by WARREN'S TONY R. soon after entering the final turn, and prevailed after a stretch long battle. WARREN'S TONY R. away alertly and stalked the pace three wide into the second turn, advanced four wide approaching the final turn, rallied three wide through the turn, and was nipped at the wire after a stretch long duel. OLAXSA unhurried early while dropping back to trail, rallied one from the rail from between rival entering the final turn and closed well four wide through the stretch. DREXEL tracked the dueling leaders one from the rail through the stretch the first time, advanced from along the inside in the run down the backstretch, and closed three wide in the lane. NORTHWAY vied for the lead from along the rail into the first turn, battled through the final turn from along the inside, checked when in tight quarters leaving the final turn, and closed one from the rail late. LATE NITE LARRY stalked the pace four wide into the second turn, dropped back in the run down the backside, and failed to menace. WHISTLER GOLD was taken in hand in the early stages and lagged towards the back of the field, posted a mild bid approaching the final turn but was never a serious factor. SURPRISAL broke sharply and dueled for the lead one from the rail through the stretch the first time, began to drop back approaching the final turn and had nothing left in the late going. Following this race there was a jockey's claim of foul. The rider of NORTHWAY lodged a claim of foul against the rider of SUFI DANCER for alleged interference entering the stretch. After review the stewards made no change to the original order of finish.
