Footnotes

OUR COCO BEANS broke sharply, pressed the pace from off the rail, gained the lead on the backstretch, just lasted being ridden out. RECALLED trailed for the first half mile, rallied from three wide, closed and just missed. BESPOKE away alertly, tracked the leaders from off the rail, three wide on the backstretch, weakened. MAGIC THUNDER broke sharply, allowed to settle, stalked the pace from the inside, was outrun in the stretch. THESEFOOLISHTHINGS unhurried early, gaining from off the rail, failed to menace. DESTINYSSILVERLACE broke sharply, assumed command and drew clear, set the pace, gave way. KONA DAYBREAK never far back, gaining from three wide, was through after five eighths.
