P. S. TOUCH DOWN away alertly, gaining from off the rail, gained the lead from four wide on the backstretch, bore in at the five sixteenth pole, drew off and was ridden out. DASHING DAISY broke sharply, chased the leaders from off the rail, rallied from three wide and was second best. CARAWAY broke sharply, pressed the pace from the inside, weakened in the stretch. UPPER CRUST broke sharply, gained command, set a pressured pace on the two path, gave way. SHELBYANN broke sharply, chased the leaders, three wide on the backstretch, was in tight and steadied at the five sixteenth pole, weakened. JUMP TO IT slow early, trailed far back, showed little. Following the race there was two riders claims of foul. The riders of UPPER CRUST and SHELBYANN claimed foul against the rider of P.S. TOUCHDOWN for interference at the five sixteenth pole. After review P.S. TOUCHDOWN was disqualified and placed fifth for bearing in causing SHELBYANN to check.
