MONSTERINTHECLOSET broke sharply and was close up, chased the leaders from the inside, rallied and gained the lead on the final turn, prevailed driving. BAD SNEAKERS broke sharply, assumed command, set the pace from off the rail, gave way. DUELLING PISTOL unhurried early, put in a late rally from four wide and finished well. FULL POWER AHEAD slow early, made a middle move from three wide, rallied and finished well. RALLYING CRY slow early, made a late rally on the inside to gain a minor share. MILITARY DEPUTY in the middle of the pack, tracked the leaders from off the rail, weakened after three quarters. SHENANDOAH RIVER never far back, gaining from three wide, weakened after the half. CLASSIC IDEALS broke sharply, pressed the pace from three wide, was through after the half. CANDLESTICK PARK trailed for most of the trip and showed little. SCOTS PINE away alertly and close up, chased the leaders from three and four wide, was through after three quarters.
