SURPRISAL away alertly, chased the leaders from four wide, gained the from the outside on the second turn, led the rest of the way and won driving. SARATOGA AVENUE pinched back early, gaining from off the rail, rallied on the inside, closed and was second best. TILL THE STORM never far back, stalked the pace from off the rail, rallied from four wide and finished well. HARLEM bumped at the start, trailed early, gaining from off the rail, rallied from four wide and finished well. HENRY WEST broke sharply, gained the early lead, set the early pace from the inside, gave way. BROTHER JAKE slow early, gaining from off the rail, failed to menace. BEARS TIGER in the middle of the pack, stalked the pace from three wide, weakened after three quarters. SPICE TRADER broke sharply, pressed the pace from the outside, was through after a half. BEARS HOME RUN in the middle of the pack, clipped heels on the second turn and fell. VALDERO well placed from off the rail, broke down on the second turn causing BEARS HOME RUN to clip his heels. Following the race there was a steward s enquiry and a riders claim of foul. The rider of SARATOGA AVENUE claimed foul against the rider of SURPRISAL for interference on the second turn. After review the claim of foul was disallowed. The stewards also viewed the incident with a horses breaking down and another clipping heels. No action was taken.
