NORTHWAY away well and tracked the leaders into the backstretch racing two from the rail, engaged the leader three wide entering the final turn, took command leaving the turn and was able to hold off a closing RAISING MEMO in deep stretch. RAISING MEMO broke sharply and stalked the dueling leaders into the backstretch racing two from the rail, rallied three wide entering the fin al turn and was gaining in the closing strides. TOMMY D' HORSEY settled well off the early pace racing three wide into the backstretch, rallied four wide on the final turn, and closed willingly while dropping inside the top pair mid way through the stretch. TARUE GRIT away alertly and dueled for the lead through the first turn from the outside of LATE NITE LARRY, took command approaching the final turn but was quickly collared by NORTHWAY, battled with that rival into the turn but faded in the stretch drive. DREXEL stalked the leaders while saving ground along the inside into the backstretch, rallied three wide entering the final turn, but needed more of a closing response in the drive. LATE NITE LARRY vied for the lead from along the rail into the backstretch, began to weaken mid way down the backside and had little to offer in the late going. following the race LATE NITE LARRY was vanned off. IMDADUDEWITATITUDE unhurried early while dropping back to trail, and was never a factor. MR. INSTIGATOR settled off the leaders racing four wide into the backstretch, but showed little while dropping back over the final furlong.
