BEARROCK N ROLL broke sharply and tracked the pacesetter through the stretch the first time, pressed the leader three wide entering the backstretch, battled into the final turn from the outside of SEMINOLE BRAVE, opened a clear advantage through the final turn and widened his margin through the stretch. QUECHEE unhurried early while dropping back to trail racing one from the rail, rallied four wide on the final turn and closed one from the rail through the lane to prove clearly second best. ONE'S OWN ACCORD stalked the leaders racing four wide through the second turn, rallied five wide into the final turn, and closed four wide through the stretch drive while improving his position. WAILIN' JACK away well and stalked the leaders two from the rail through the stretch the first time, rallied three wide entering the final turn, was forced to steady soon after entering the stretch, and closed three wide through the lane. SILLY FELLA stalked the leaders from along the rail into the second turn while under snug restraint, rallied one from the rail through the final turn, but needed more of a closing response when called upon in the lane. SEMINOLE BRAVE away alertly and raced to the lead entering the first turn racing out from the rail, vied for the lead from the inside of BEARROCK N ROLL upon entering the backstretch, was unable to match strides with that foe entering the final turn, and weakened through the late stages.
