Footnotes

MORRIE'S GLORY broke sharply and tracked the early leader one from the rail through the stretch the first time, engaged the leader approaching the final turn and quickly took command, and drew off through the stretch. GOLDEN ROAR away alertly and tracked the pacesetter while racing two from the rail into the stretch the first time, rallied three wide on the final turn and proved clearly second best while no threat to the winner. ACCEPTABLE HENNA settled off the early pace racing four wide into the second turn, advanced five wide upon entering the backstretch, rallied four wide through the final turn and improved her position in the final furlong while no threat to the top pair. VICTORIA B raced to the lead from along the rail into the first turn, was tackled by MORRIE'S GLORY approaching the final turn and faded in the stretch drive. Following the race VICTORIA B appeared to take a bad step and unseated her rider and was vanned off. QUIET TAP had her start hampered by the loose horse and dropped well off the early pace, rallied along the inside on the final turn and closed five wide through the stretch while improving her position. WHOSECASH away well and stalked the leaders while racing one from the rail, held a striking position to the final turn, but lacked the needed closing response when called upon. DORREEN'S DELIGHT had her start hampered by the loose horse, lagged at the back of the field and showed little. GRIEVANCE settled off the early leaders while saving ground at the rail, rallied along the inside entering the final turn but needed more in the late stages. RAVENETTE settled just off the early pace while racing one from the rail, but began to weaken as

the approached the final turn. MACARENA STAR showed no early speed while racing one from the rail through the stretch the first time, but was never a factor. MAZEL'S SECRET broke outward and bumped with a rival to her outside and unseated her rider, The final time for this race was HAND TIMED.
