HOPE FAITH GOLD broke sharply and raced to the lead from just off the rail entering the first turn, turned back a challenge from BY FOHR NOW approaching the final turn, and inched clear in the lane. TIMELY FLIGHT was carried eight wide entering the first turn while falling well off the early pace, rallied one from the rail on the final turn and closed gamely three wide through the lane to get up for the place. DOWNHILL DAISY away alertly and tracked the pacesetter into the backstretch while saving ground along the inside, rallied along the rail on the final turn and battled gamely through the stretch one from the rail. EILEEN IS A SAINT stalked the pace from along the inside into the backstretch, rallied along the rail on the final turn and battled gamely from along the inside in the stretch drive. EXOTIC LIGHT dropped back to trail entering the first turn racing two from the rail, rallied eight wide entering the final turn and closed eight wide in the stretch drive. KACHING CASH was off a step slow, and lagged well back early, rallied five wide into the final turn and

closed willingly six wide through the stretch. TENZEL was squeezed between rivals entering the first turn and forced to steady, rallied three wide into the final turn in an even effort. SPRINGINTOFASHION was carried six wide entering the first turn, lagged well off the pacesetters down the backstretch, rallied three wide into the final turn, but needed more when called upon. NAUGHTY LIBRARIAN drifted wide into the first turn carrying rivals out with her, rallied six wide through the final turn, but failed to seriously menace. BY FOHR NOW away well and tracked the leader into the backstretch racing two from the rail, pressed the pace to the final turn, before weakening.
