With \$1,000 to enter and an additional \$1,000 to pass scratch time. A supplementary and pre-entry, that includes the entry fee, will be accepted on October 15, 2008 for \$10,000. 100% of all supplemental monies will be added to the top of the \$100,000 Guaranteed purse as determined after scratch time. All supplemental nominees will be pre-entered in the race. Entry and supplemental fees will be refunded to any horse that fails to draw into this race due to preference requirements. With \$100,000 Guaranteed to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. TOMMY DANZIGGER never far back, stalked the pace from three wide, rallied from four wide, gained the lead in the late stretch and won driving. GOTTA FIND BUBBA broke sharply, chased the pace setter from the rail, rallied on the inside, gained the lead on the final turn, gave way. MILLWRIGHT never far back, stalked the pace from three wide, rallied from four wide and was outrun. SENOR ROJO broke sharply and was well placed, stalked the pace from the inside, put in a mild rally and was outrun. DIAMOND QUEST stumbled at the start, slow early, put in a mild bid to gain a minor share. TEN YEARS AFTER trailed for the first three quarter, showed little and only passed tiring rivals. NUCLEAR PROSPECT broke sharply, stalked the pace from three wide, was through after three quarters. EL SINALOENSE broke sharply, assumed command, set the pace from the two path, gave way.
