MILITARY DEPUTY unhurried early, stalked the pace from off the rail, rallied from three wide, gained the lead on the backstretch, drew off being ridden out. DIAMONDS LIL DEVIL unhurried early, gaining, rallied from three wide on the final turn, was second best but no match for the winner. JUST LIKE DREADS trailed for the first mile and a quarter, rallied from four wide and finished well. LORD VIC gained command from off the rail, set the pace, drew off, gave way on the backstretch. GREAT PRINCE well placed, stalked the pace from off rail, weakened in the stretch. BEAU RUN unhurried early, stalked the pace from off the rail, failed to menace. VINTNER pressed the early pace from very wide, was through after a mile and dropped back.
