Footnotes

BLEAK OUTLOOK dueled early while three wide, angled off the rail into the turn with a long drive in the stretch and prevailed in the final stages. PAWS PRINCE dueled early from between horses, while on the inside into the turn with a long drive in the stretch but was outfinished late. SIR DAKOTA was well placed early, angled into the five path in the turn with some late gain in the stretch run. WIN TUCKER broke out at the start, angled into the three path in the turn and moved up in the stretch. RED WINE was back early, fanned into the eight path in the turn and improved position late. TAURUS THE BULL chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn and weakened late. BAYOU PALACE angled into the five path in the turn while no threat. RARE POWER was never a factor. OAK RICH was done early. JOYFUL FRIEND was never involved. BRENT'S BAD BOY was in tight early and then steadied, dropped back. BOOT SCOOTIN BABY pressed inside early then pulled up and was walked off.
