SAUCY'S GOT IT set the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn then drew away late in the stretch under a steady drive. MR. GREEN tracked the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn and weakened late in the stretch. SPEEDY MEDIA was unhurried early, angled into the four path in the turn and moved up in the stretch drive. RAHY NIJMIS was unhurried early, angled off the rail into the turn and improved position. WHY STILLY WHY angled into the five path in the turn while no threat. PAINTED FOREST was on the inside into the turn and was empty in the stretch. CAVANAUGH was through after a half. PURPLE SUTHERLAND was done early. DANCEUPONTHESTARS had early speed then retreated.
