Footnotes

OUR ROCK STAR vied for the lead along the inside into the lane, shook off dueling challenger entering the lane, was joined by another outside the eighth pole, shook free from that one near the sixteenth pole and extended. MOTOWN BOY chased the pace while well off the inside, bid three to four wide into the lane, moved to the winner outside the eighth pole, loomed a serious threat then leveled and finished second best. NORTHERN CANDYRIDE raced near the inside into the lane then lacked the needed rally. PROHIBITIVE raced five wide into the lane then could not offer the needed response. MAN FROM MARS was six wide into the lane and was never a serious threat. SATANGO was never a factor while saving ground. INDY BULL vied for the lead into the lane then gave way. BOY'S BROTHER BOB was outrun while near the inside. MARDI GRAS PARTY was off slowly, racing well back and never menaced. SHADOWY SLEW was steadied soon after the start when in tight then was never in it. SEEYOUINAHUMMER was well back while in the four or five path into the lane. ROCKY ROX chased the pace from the three path into the turn then retreated through mid-turn.
