**Footnotes**

SUN VALLEY STORM tracked the pace along the inside into mid-turn, came off the rail while moving to the leader, moved past that one entering the lane then was kept to the task to the end while under hand urging. CLASSIC GAIT was in the three to four path through the turn, bid into the lane, was no match for the winner while clearly second best. ZAVABELLE set the pace into late turn then gave way entering the lane. TWO TEARS stalked the pace from the two path into the turn then weakened in the drive. MODEL'S MEMO moved five wide into the lane and moved up while never a menace. TAPITSDONTLIE bid four wide into the lane then tired in the final eighth. MY HONEY was in contention into the turn then steadily lost ground. COUNTESS KATIE was outrun while racing near the inside. CON LOVER was in the five or six path into the turn and never factored. DEBBIE'S ROSE trailed throughout while in the five path.
