Footnotes

GOLD BELLS SPIN stalked the pace early, angled into the four path in the far turn, drew clear in the stretch but lasted at the wire. ROYAL LUCKEY was unhurried early, angled into the three path in the far turn, rallied in the stretch from the rail and just missed at the finish. QSAR (GER) tracked the pace early, angled into the five path in the far turn, loomed in the stretch but did not have enough in the final stages. ALOHA LOVE was well placed early, angled into the four path in the far turn and weakened late. FRENCHMAN'S COVE set the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn and gave way in the stretch run. VICTORY LOPE angled into the five path in the far turn while no threat. BALLACOLLA was never a factor. CITIZEN JOHN was done early.
