**Footnotes**

TAPITFORPAR settled off the early pace while in the three path, moved to the pacesetters approaching the lane and drove past after straightening. BURGANDY BLUSH pressed the pace two wide through the turn, was passed by the winner in the lane and was all out to regain the place spot. BELLE'S BEAMER dueled for the lead along the inside into the lane then weakened in the final eighth. DEFIANT DARLING raced evenly from the inside. SIMPLY THE FOX raced behind the pace into the lane, angled into the four path for the drive and tired. HOMEROOM ANGEL raced in the five path into the lane and was never in it. TO ROME trailed throughout while well off the rail.
