VAN GOGO GIRL chased the pace while in the two path through the turn, moved to the leader entering the lane, got the lead over the tiring pacesetter and quickly opened a clear advantage then was all out to last. ROWDY STELLA chased the pace four wide through the turn, bid into the lane, was gaining momentum inside the sixteenth pole and just missed in a sharp effort. AIDEN'S INDY sprinted clear at once, maintained a clear advantage into the lane then yielded to the winner and was all out to hold the show spot. TAP MAGIC was in the three path through the turn and lacked the needed rally. REILLYS BIRDSTONE was along the inside into the lane and lost ground through the stretch. MAMMAL OF ACTION chased the pace three wide through the turn when in good position then tired in the drive. HI JULIE was in the three or four path through the turn and was never in it. LADY REDNECK was through early while in the four path.
