DOT'S IN STYLE set the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn then drew off in the stretch under a brisk drive. ZONGA ZING stalked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn while no match for the winner in the stretch run. ROSE RUN was well placed early, angled into the five path in the turn and moved up in the stretch drive. HELLO MONDAY tracked the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn and weakened late. MISS DIANE chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn and faded late in the stretch. HAWAIIAN SKY was never a threat. JUST PICK ME showed little. PERFECTLY CANDID was done early.
