Footnotes

SODA JERK raced behind a three horse duel through the turn, swept past those entering the lane and widened under a drive. JACK IN THE PULPIT raced three wide into the lane when never far back then gained the place spot late while not a threat to the winner. MARATHON MOON was along the inside through the turn, benefited when others came off the inside, was a serious contender outside the eighth pole then could not sustain the effort. ONE SKY vied for the lead with two others while along the inside then gave way entering the lane. SEA OF ENQUIRY vied for the lead from between rivals into the lane then tired. BOZENA angled widest into the lane and never factored. PERFECT SATURDAY was four wide into the lane and was never a serious contender. KOKA KOLA OCEAN vied for the lead three wide and retreated entering the lane. TEMPERANCE TIME raced at the back the first sixteenth and was pulled up after breaking down.
