Footnotes

BOLD TAP trailed early while off the inside, began gaining momentum in mid-turn, swung into the lane from the four path then ran down the clear leader inside the sixteenth pole. THEMOONANDTHESTARS ran off to a clear lead soon after the start, extended the advantage into the lane then could not hold off the winner while second best. ZONE raced off the inside into the lane, looked to split entering the lane, lost path,altered to the rail then was moving well late. GLORIFIED PRINCESS was three wide through the turn then lacked a bid through the lane. DAKOTA DIM was in the three path into the lane, contended with an eighth to go then lacked a response. STORM N ROSIE LACE was never a factor while saving ground. RED FOR THE CURE was four wide into the lane and lost ground through the lane. STRONG N TRUE chased the pace along the inside through the turn then faded. WEB WE WEAWE was through early while in the four or five path. LEEDONNA bid two wide through the turn then retreated entering the lane.
