Footnotes

RAHY NIJMIS was settled off the pace early, while on the inside into the turn then got thru inside the three sixteenth pole and held in the final stages. ASTAIRE pressed the pace early while three wide, angled into the four path in the turn then made a bid in the stretch but did not have enough late. SPEEDY MEDIA tracked the pace early while four wide, angled into the five path in the turn then made a bid in the stretch but hung late. BETATRON vied for the lead early while between horses, angled into the three path in the turn and weakened late in the stretch run. CURLY was unhurried early, angled off the rail into the turn with a mild gain in the stretch drive. DEW DETIME was well placed early, angled into the four path in the turn and flattened out in the stretch. RUPERTS COOKIE set the pace early from the inside, angled off the rail into the turn and gave way in the stretch. CLASSICAL RHYTHM was never a threat. SPURTABILITY was through after a half. CRAIG'S TYLER was never involved. TRICKY CHIEF showed little.
