COMMONWEALTH RUSH chased the two horse duel through the turn while in the three path, bid into the lane and rushed past the leaders inside the sixteenth pole and cleared. DADDY J U dueled for the lead from along the inside from the outset, remained with a narrow advantage inside the sixteenth pole and was passed by the winner late. MEET BY THE RIVER dueled two wide into the lane,was still battling for the lead late when passed by the winner late and could not get past the runner-up. WAKES WEEK was in the three path through the turn and never seriously threatened. GOTTA GO GOLD was in the two or three path through the turn and never factored. M'NAUGHTEN was near the inside throughout and was never in it. THE BERRY EDGE chased the pace along the inside into the turn, broke down near the three eighths pole and was subsequently humanely destroyed. FINAL PITSTOP was trailing into the turn then fell over a fallen foe, got up and jogged back to barn area.
