Footnotes

LIEPERS FORK settled early while racing in the four path, bid leaving the turn, was straightened in the lane then finished full of run to draw away late. BIG PAIN just off the pace early, moved to engage the leaders three wide on the turn, got clear in the lane then was not good enough for the winner while finishing second best. FOUR COLUMNS raced three wide into the turn, dropped closer to the rail late in the turn then could not keep up while holding the show spot. WHAT A REBEL saved ground into the lane then drifted out when roused. ICE KING raced close up into the lane while just off the rail then had no response in the lane. LAC A ROCK bid through the turn from the four path but could not make up ground and was never a threat. DANJO raced in the five path through the turn then offered a mild rally from the center of the track. DOLLAR FOR DOLLAR saved ground to no avail. MIXER forced the pace from the inside early then gave way after 1/2. PIZZA BOY was outrun from off the rail. HEZA WILD GUY was outrun from just off the rail. SINGLES LAST KISS raced in the six path through the turn and trailed throughout.
